

"I really like OPAL lunch times because it gives us new opportunities. You can use your imagination to work things out. There is so much to play with and you can build dens."


"I love the boats. My brothers are the sharks and we are on the boat!"


Next week, we will start to work with school councillors so that they can start to collect ideas from their classes about how the children in school would like to see OPAL developing.

WORLD BOOK DAY BOOK SWAP

HARDSHIP GRANT COMMUNITY FUND

We are pleased to announce the opening of BVSC's Hardship Grant Community Fund, part of Birmingham City Council's wider Household Support Fund (HSF) activity for this Winter. BVSC will be distributing grants of up to £200 to Birmingham households currently facing hardship, intended for support with food and energy payments. Green Meadow is a registered trusted partner for this scheme and can apply on your behalf. Please contact the school office and ask to speak with Mrs Cross or Mrs Robinson. *Please note if you have successfully applied for the grant in previous rounds you will not be eligible again.*

When does it start?

Applications will commence from **Monday 6th January** and we will continue to accept applications until 31st March 2023, or all funding has been exhausted if sooner.

Who is eligible?

- You must be a Birmingham Resident.
- You must be experiencing hardship, particularly with regards to covering costs linked to food and energy.
- You must not have recieved Household Support Fund grants in previous rounds.
