# **Attendance Update**

During the season of coughs and colds, we have noticed a higher than normal level of absence due to illness. We know that some children will be absent from school because they are poorly. This is absolutely fine, school does not expect children to attend school if they are ill. However, as part of our duty of care and safeguarding procedures, it is very important that school know when children are going to have an absence. We thought it would be a helpful time to remind all parents of our procedures for reporting absences.

#### Reporting absence from school

Where a pupil is to be absent from school without prior permission (for example if they wake up feeling poorly and are unfit for school), the parent/carer should inform school by telephone on the morning of the day of the first absence and let school know when they expect the pupil to return. Please phone the office between 8.15am and 8.45am to do this. If the return date is not confirmed on the first day of absence, parents/carers must contact school on each day of absence. On the day of return to school, parents must also provide written confirmation of the reason(s) for the full period of absence.

In cases of prolonged absence due to illness or where absence due to illness is above 10%, the parents/cares may be asked to provide school with medical evidence, such as a note from the child's doctor. If this evidence is not provided, the absence may be marked as unauthorised.

#### **Appointments**

Medical, dental and other essential appointments for a pupil should take place outside of school hours where this is reasonably possible. Where an appointment must take place during school time, the pupil should attend school for as much of the day as possible and as much prior notice as possible should be given to the school office, who will inform all relevant staff members. For the time absent from school to be marked as an authorised, confirmation of the appointment by way of an appointment card or letter must be provided.

# Wintry Weather!

Now that the weather has turned so much colder, I thought it a good time to remind everyone of our procedures when there is ice and snow. Whilst we endeavour to avoid any disruption to school, in the event of snow or ice on the site, there are times when it is necessary to restrict entry to the school site via the main gate if conditions on site are dangerous. In the event of this happening, a text message to all parents is sent from school. We do everything possible to ensure that school remains open when there is wintry weather but if conditions become unsafe, in the rare event of school closure, school aims to inform you of this as early as possible via text and a message on the homepage of our website. Please ensure your contact details are up to date on Arbor.


