For children to reach their full potential at school, it is really important that they are in school on time every day. The more children are in school, the more they will learn! Inevitably, there may be some occasions during the year when your child is not able to attend school because of illness for example. If your child is not able to come into school, please let us know as soon as you are able to by contacting the school office on 0121 475 4505.

ABSENCE...

What YOU must do:

Try to telephone the school between 8 and 8.30am each day of your child's absence. Tell the school in advance, of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters.

If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival.

Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport, call on a family member, neighbour or friend.

If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What WE will do:

Check your child's attendance every day.

Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.

Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.

If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.
