Dear Parents/Carers,

Green Meadow has been on a journey to become a Trauma informed Attachment Aware School (TIAAS) over the last 12 months. All members of staff have received training in this, which includes Emotion Coaching, an evidence based whole school approach in responding to children's emotions. Using this approach and ethos is based on building and having positive and trusting relationships and creates an environment where everyone feels emotionally safe and where the most vulnerable children can recover from trauma and/or attachment.

The school will be visited on Wednesday 22nd November by an Educational Psychologist from the TIAAS team and as part of the accreditation process, they would like to hear from our parents and carers about how you see and feel Green Meadow supports your child/children. We would really appreciate it if you could complete the short questionnaire attached by Friday 24th November. You can do this by scanning the barcode on a mobile phone or device or follow the link below and then submitting it directly to the TIAAS team. If you are unable to complete it this way, please let school know and we will arrange for a paper version to be sent to you.


