The mathletics trophies were awarded to Gazelles and Giraffes this week for amassing so many points! Well done, everyone! What superstars you are!






Well done to all of the children who have been practising their spelling on Spelling Shed this week.

#### Measles



Currently, there is an increasing number of people in Birmingham with measles.

#### **MEASLES SYMPTOMS**

If children develop symptoms of measles, parents should contact their GP surgery or 111. They should NOT go to the GP, to A&E or any other setting without calling ahead. Staff will make special arrangements to see patients so that if they have measles, they won't pass it to others.

The first signs of measles are:

- high temperature
- runny or blocked nose
- sneezing
- cough
- · red, sore, watery eyes
- rash usually appears a few days after cold-like symptoms (sometimes starts around the ears before spreading to rest of the body)







