
The **Mathletics trophies** were awarded to **Shakespeare** and **Giraffes** this week for amassing so many points! Well done, everyone! What superstars you are!

Year 4, who will go swimming from Monday, 29th April until Friday 10th May.







Please keep up to date with school meal payments each week.

Please note that for Reception, Year I and Year 2 <u>ALL</u> children are entitled to universal free school meals.

As you are aware, Excelsior MAT have subsidised the price of our school dinners over the last couple of years. Due to further cost increases from City Serve, it is necessary to increase the price of school meals after the Easter break to £3.00 per day. We wanted to make you aware of this price increase as soon as possible.
