Reception have been finding out all about the Sikh Gurdwara decorations and learning how to make their own.








Year 1 have been learning about the celebration of Holi and have created paintings to represent this colourful event!

The Friends of Green Meadow (FOGM) would like to invite all existing and new parents, caregivers and relatives to our Annual General Meeting.


