Dear Parents and Carers,


Happy Friday, everyone! And what a fabulous Friday it's been. It's been great to see all of the children supporting this year's Red Nose Day!

The Mathletics trophies were awarded to Shakespeare and Giraffes this week for amassing so many points! Well done, everyone! What superstars you are!






Well done to all of the children who have been practising their spelling on Spelling Shed this week.
