CELEBRATING GREAT LEARNING!



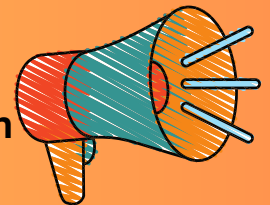

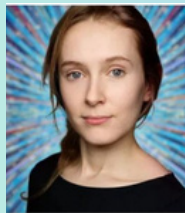
