Well done to all the children in school who received hot chocolate nominations from their teachers for **GOING ABOVE AND BEYOND!**

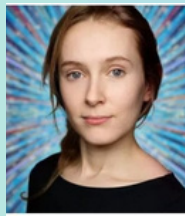

We hope the children have enjoyed attending the clubs this term and would like to thank all of the staff who have given their time to run them.

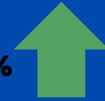
GMPS ATTENDANCE BY NUMBER

RUNNING COST OF FINES ISSUED TO GREEN MEADOW PARENTS THIS ACADEMIC YEAR- £15, 133



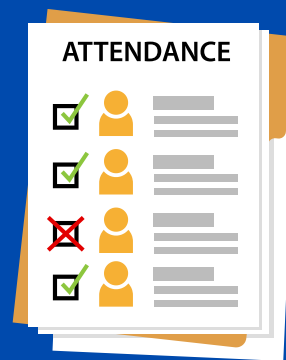
